Information Sheet for Preventative Care

Since early stages of cancer can be difficult to see or feel, regular screening is a way to detect cancers sooner. Detecting cancer sooner leads to treatment faster. Based on Cancer Care Ontario Guidelines, Upper Canada Family Health Team is focused on three screening processes:

Cervical Cancer Screening

 Women age 21-69, that have ever been sexually active, are screened by having a pap test every 3 years

Breast Cancer Screening

- Women age 50-74 are screened by having a mammogram every 2 years

Colorectal Cancer Screening

- Women and men age 50-74 screen by completing a FIT (Fecal Immunochemical Testing) every 2 years
 - FIT consists of collecting a small stool sample on a provided sampling stick
 - FIT kits are supplied and mailed out from LifeLabs

OR

A colonoscopy every 10 years, as directed by your doctor
